

HAVERSHAM CENTRAL

Set loosely in the 1960's Haversham Central depicts a busy town / city. It is a fictitious location in a central position allowing trains from various regions to have reason to pass through. Built in N gauge it allows a lot of operating potential in a small space (5'x2'9).

Its station sees many passenger trains stopping from various parts of the country, whilst the engine sheds and goods yards allow for some shunting. Steam and diesel are seen with both the Golden Arrow and the Midland Blue Pullman passing through regularly.
